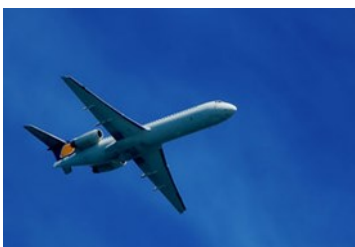
English for Oil and Gas
